

## Amir Hadzic Head Men's Soccer Coach

Hadzic has helmed the Mount Mercy men's soccer program for 25 seasons. In 2011, Mount Mercy won its first-ever conference regular season and tournament titles and reached the NAIA national tournament for the first time in school history. Hadzic led the Mustangs back to nationals again in 2015.

Hadzic is also head boys' soccer coach at Xavier High School. In all, 21 of Hadzic's Mount Mercy players have become head coaches throughout the country, including six in the Cedar Rapids and Iowa City area.

#### Alen Kudumovic Head Women's Soccer Coach

Kudumovic became the head coach for women's soccer in December 2019. He graduated from Mount Mercy in 2003 with a degree in business administration and earned a masters in strategic leadership from the university in 2018. While pursuing his graduate degree, he served as the graduate assistant coach for the Mustang men's soccer program from 2016-18.

Kudumovic has been the director of coaching at the Cedar River Soccer Association (CRSA) since 2010, managing all aspects of the organization from coaching to organizing camps and showcase events to budgeting and scheduling. From 2003-10, he was a professional coach with CRSA. Kudumovic also coached with the Heartland Soccer Club and was the head boys' soccer coach at Iowa City High School from 2001-03.

# Sho Takaoka Assistant Camp Director

Takaoka was a four-year member of the Mount Mercy men's soccer team, playing mostly on defense. He was a foreign exchange student his junior year at Cedar Rapids Kennedy High School, then returned to his native



Japan for his senior year where he was also a member of several Japanese soccer clubs. Takaoka returned to Iowa to play for the Mustangs and was an important part of Mount Mercy's 2015 NAIA national tournament team. He is currently the graduate assistant coach at Mount Mercy, coaches at CRSA soccer club in Cedar Rapids, and is helping coach the Cedar Rapids Xavier boys' soccer team. Takaoka was also an assistant coach at Linn-Mar High School in the spring of 2018.
